CCAT has four joint research centres, based at:

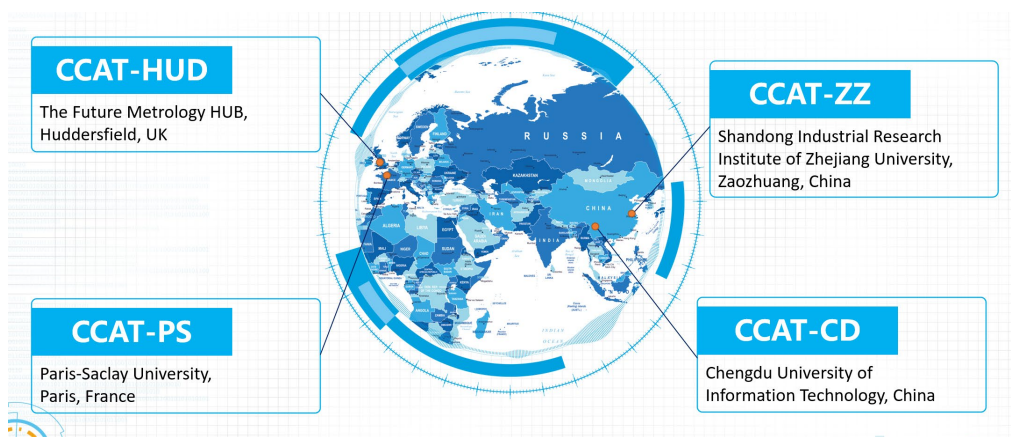
