## Single User License

### Short version

This is a Single User Font License, which is intended for the following:

- One user for personal or commercial use
- installation on up to 3 devices (including personal computers, laptops, tablets, smartphones)

You can:

- use for personal and commercial projects including publications with a distribution of up to 500.
- send to a printer with viewing and printing rights
- use font images on a website

You cannot:

- share it
- sell it
- give it to another person or organisation
- install on more than three devices
- embed the font in documents, apps or web pages except for viewing or printing purposes.
- modify font data
- use it for publications with a distribution of 500 or more.

Additional licensing is required for:

- use of the font by more than one user (multi-user, site or enterprise license required)
- use of the font in more than three devices (multi-user, site or enterprise license required)
- use of the font in:
  - ebooks
  - mobile apps
  - webfonts
  - other embedding uses that require live or interactive text applications
- use in publications with a distribution of 500 or more (publication licence extension required).
- branding identity

## Full version

Thank you for licensing fonts from Iain Macleod Associates Ltd (IMA). This is a legal agreement between the end user and Iain Macleod Associates Ltd. By using the font software you are agreeing to be bound by the terms of this agreement. If you do not agree to be bound by the terms of this agreement then you should delete all copies of the software; a signed and dated undertaking that all copies have been deleted is required in order to receive a refund.

### 1 DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 Font software – software code that is used in the generation of letters or symbols in a font or typeface used in printed or digital media.
- 1.2 End User License Agreement (EULA) - a legal agreement defining the permissible uses of the font software.
- 1.3 End User – You, or the company or entity you represent, purchasing this license and bound by the EULA.
- 1.4 Device – computer, tablet, smartphone or other machine using the font software.
- 1.5 Site – a single geographical location where an organization has an operation

### 2 USAGE

- 2.1 Copyright. The font software is owned by Iain Macleod Associates Ltd, and protected by United Kingdom copyright law and international treaty provisions.
- 2.2 Grant of license. The end user is permitted to make use of the font software for personal or commercial purposes within the limitations defined in this license agreement.
- 2.3 Number of users. This is a single user license, so the individual license holder is the only permitted user.
- 2.4 Number of installations. The End User is permitted to install the font software on a maximum of three devices. If the font software is installed in a network server, the End User must have licenses for each device attached to the network (either multiple single user licenses, a multi-user license, a site license or an enterprise license).
- 2.5 Copying. The End User is permitted to make a single copy of the font software for back-up purposes. The End User is responsible for the back-up copy.
- 2.6 Sharing. The End User is not permitted to share the font software with any other party.
- 2.7 Selling and leasing. The End User is not permitted to sell, lease or distribute the font software to any other party unless they have a written agreement with Iain Macleod Associates Ltd to the contrary.
- 2.8 Transfer. The End User is permitted to transfer the license to another single user, provided that:-
  - All materials, including the font software and back-up copy are transferred
  - All materials, including the font software and back-up copy, are deleted from the originating End User's devices
  - The recipient agrees to be bound by the terms of this agreement
  - Iain Macleod Associates Ltd are notified with details of the new license holder.

- 2.9 Modification. The End User is not permitted to modify the font software.
- 2.10 Font embedding. The font may be embedded in documents for viewing and printing purposes. Embedding the font in a document is not permitted if it enables another party to extract or modify the font, or to create a new document using the font software.
- 2.11 Use in websites. The End User is permitted to use the font software for the display of text and graphical images on websites, so long as the text or images cannot be edited or downloaded. Using the font in a website is not permitted if it enables another party to extract or modify the font, or to create a new document using the font software.
- 2.12 Use in publications. The End User is permitted to use the font software for printed and digital publications, such as books or magazine articles, with a volume of up to 500 units or copies. For larger volume publications, a publication license is required.
- 2.13 Updates. Updated versions of the font software may become available from time to time. At the discretion of Iain Macleod Associates Ltd, these may be offered to registered users for a nominal fee.
- 2.14 End User's responsibility. The End User agrees to inform any individual or organization having access to the font software of the terms and conditions of this EULA. The End User agrees to sole liability for any loss damage or claim of whatsoever nature including pure economic loss and any consequential loss arising from a breach of the terms of this EULA.
- 3 OTHER LICENSE OPTIONS. The following licenses are also available, priced on a case-by-case basis:
- Multi-user licenses. These extend usage rights to the number of End Users requested.
  - Site license. This extends usage rights to all persons based at a specific site for an organization.
  - Enterprise license. This extends usage rights to all persons within an organization spread over multiple sites or locations.
  - Publication license extension. This extends usage rights to publications produced in volumes greater than 500 units.
  - Additional licensing options are available on request.
- 4 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. The font software and any accompanying documentation are made available in good faith, but without any claim regarding fitness for purpose, correctness, accuracy, completeness, or currency. The End User makes use of the font software entirely at their own risk. Iain Macleod Associates Ltd shall not be liable or responsible for any loss damage or claim of whatsoever nature including pure economic loss and any consequential loss howsoever arising, occasioned by the correct or incorrect usage of the font software.
- 5 LIMITED WARRANTY  
Iain Macleod Associates Ltd warrants that the font software is free of errors and will be replaced within 90 days of purchase in the event of defective media. If failure of the font software results from accident, abuse, or neglect, Iain Macleod Associates Ltd assumes no responsibility to replace the software.
- 6 TERMINATION. Iain Macleod Associates Ltd shall have the right to terminate this agreement at any time if the End User fails to comply with its terms and provisions. Upon termination of this agreement, the End User agrees to delete all copies of the font software, including back-ups.
- 7 FORCE MAJEURE. Failure of either party to perform its obligations under this agreement shall not subject such party to any liability to the other if such failure is caused or occasioned by an act of God, fire explosion, flood, drought, war, riot, sabotage, embargo, strikes or other labour unrest, interruption due to the delay in transportation, compliance with any order, regulation or request of any government of competent jurisdiction or any officer, department, agency or committee thereof, or by any other event or circumstance of like or different character to the foregoing beyond the reasonable control of the party so failing to perform.

8 GOVERNING LAW. The Terms and Conditions of this EULA shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law.

9 MISCELLANEOUS:

- Failure by Iain Macleod Associates Ltd to insist upon strict compliance with any provision thereof shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such provision or any other provision thereof.
- The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision thereof shall not effect the validity or enforceability of any other provision.
